Women's football team arrives in UAE for friendly

DUBAI: The Indian women's team safely reached Dubai, UAE, on Thursday for their upcoming friendlies in the UAE and Bahrain, which get underway on October 2. These friendlies have been planned as part of the team's preparation for the AFC Women's Asian Cup, which is set to take place in India next year. The Indian women's team has been camping in Jamshedpur with help from the Government of Jharkhand.

Nordics call to review women's bikini uniform

COPENHAGEN: The five Nordic countries urged the International Handball Federation to review uniform rules in accordance with gender equality after the Norway team was punished for wearing shorts instead of the mandated bikini uniform. Norway's women were fined by European handball authorities for improper clothing after wearing shorts in the European beach bronze medal match in Bulgaria in July in protest at the bikini-style rule. Men are allowed to wear T-shirts and shorts while women have to wear midriff-baring tops and bikini bottoms.

Athletics investigators take over Belarus case

MONACO: An investigation into two Belarus team officials who tried to force sprinter Krystsina Tsimanouskaya on a flight from the Tokyo Olympics will now be run by track and field authorities. World Athletics said on Thursday its independent Athletics Integrity Unit is taking over the case from the International Olympic Committee. No timetable was given for the investigation. The Belarus team's treatment of Tsimanouskaya created a diplomatic incident at the Tokyo Olympics with Japanese authorities and Poland's embassy coming to her aid.

Weightlifter Kostova banned for doping again LAUSANNE: Former world champion weightlifter Boyanka Kostova was banned for eight years for doping on Thursday after making her comeback from an earlier sanction for performance-enhancing drug use at the Olympics. The International Testing Agency said Kostova tested positive for traces of the steroid stanozolol on her way to winning the European championship title in the 59-kilogram category in April. Kostova was banned from 2016 through 2018 after a reanalysis of her sample from the 2012 Olympics, where she

placed fifth, found the steroid turinabol.

RIO DE JANEIRO: The president of the Brazilian soccer confederation was suspended for 21 months as a sexual harassment case against him proceeds. The body's general assembly on Wednesday voted 27-0 to keep Rogério Caboclo out until one month before his term ends in March 2023. The 48-year-old Caboclo, whose term began in 2019, was first suspended by the confederation's ethics committee in June after a former secretary formally made accusations against him. That decision was extended until the general assembly's vote.

Easy for rop-seeded Rublev in San Diego Open

SAN DIEGO: Top-seeded Andrey Rublev broke to begin each set and was on his way to overpowering wild-card entry Brandon Nakashima 6-2 6-1 in the second round of the San Diego Open. Rubley, fresh off helping Team Europe win the Laver Cup exhibition in Boston, on Wednesday used big forehands to take control of points from the baseline. "Since the beginning, I was thinking I need to be the one who's going to dominate. I need to try to take my forehand and try to dictate," said Rublev.

The visitors pressed for an equaliser, Luuk de Jong passing up two presentable chances, but always looked vulnerable at the back.

Nunez hit the post before Rafa Silva reacted smartly to steer in the second and Nunez later slotted in from

the spot, Barça's woes compounded by Eric García's 🌊 late red card.

Ronaldo marked his record 178th UEFA Champions League appearance with the late winner, as Manchester United edged out Villareal 2-1 in another keenly contested tie, at the Old Trafford.

The visitors had the better of the first half and David de Gea produced a string of fine saves to deny Arnaut Danjuma, Paco Alcácer and Yeremi Pino, before Alcácer did grab the opener, touching home Danjuma's cross. United soon levelled when Alex Telles volleyed in Bruno Fernandes' clever free-kick to notch his first goal for the club, but they looked to be

Rio boxing bouts under scanner even as AIBA talks tough

PTI / New Delhi

More than 10 bouts in the 2016 Rio Olympics boxing competition were manipulated for naughty and the nice. The "money" and other "perceived benefits", an independent investigation has revealed, prompting the International Boxing Association (AIBA) to promise a tough selection process for referees and judges at the upcoming men's world championship.

The first phase report of the McLaren Global Sport Solutions' independent investigation into boxing, which was accessed by PTI, has been handed to AIBA and revealed that "a system for the manipulation of bouts by officials existed at Rio". In all, 14 bouts

came under the scanner, including two finals. "It was a complete reversal

of Santa Clause's myth of the naughty were gifted an appointment at Rio because they were willing, or under pressure to support any request for manipulation, while the nice were left out," the report noted referring to the dubious appointment of officials at the Games.

The damning findings of the investigation stated that conspiracy to manipulate Rio results dated back as far back as before the London Olympics of 2012 and that a trial run was carried out during the qualifying events for the 2016 edition.

Qatar to host F1 in Nov 2023

Qatar will host a Formula One race for the first time in November and for 10 years from 2023. Qatar takes the remaining slot left vacant on this year's reshuffled calendar. The race will start under floodlights at 6 p.m. local time on Nov. 21 at the Losail International Circuit. As the 20th of 22 races

this season, it will be followed by the inaugural Saudi Arabian GP in Jeddah on Dec. 5 and the season-ending Abu Dhabi GP on Dec. 12. "There was a strong will from Qatar to be helpful to F1, and in the course of this process, the vision for a longer partnership was discussed and agreed," F1 said in a statement on Thursday.
